With a subtle interaction between contemporary vision and traditional work, the research on plumage in nature finds its interpretation in the world of tiles.

The overlapping of patterns, shapes and decorations, confer to the tiled wall the feeling of a single feather and of the global plumage at the same time.




DIAMANTINO

A lengthened diamond, three-dimensionally modelled, which immediately reminds us of ceramic tiling but also of the graphics by Gio Ponti, allows infinite color combinations, backed by the facet of the diamond.







CLINKER

Inspired by the tiling material used since the Fifties by modernist masters such as Caccia Dominioni, Gardella, Ponti and Albini, these hexagonal mosaic bricks made in black clay, features superior mechanic performances and a typical vitrified surface.




FLORA






PETALIDesigned by Angelo Spagnolo





MICROMOSAICO

Designed by Botteganove Studio

The micromosaic effect in BottegaNove mosaic tiles is obtained using a crystalline coating called "craquelè", literally "cracked". The collection is presented through square-shaped tiles characterized by an ever-different micro- decoration that identifies each individual tile as a "unique micromosaic".







PERSPECTIVE Designed by Angelo Spagnolo

Well-dealt lines hint at movement and define
a slightly asymmetrical space. In the Perspectives tiles
the flared shape in the middle becomes a decentred
dimension in which you can glimpse unusual views.
